At the end of February of this year, the River Oaks Foundation received the good news that the City of Houston had finally approved the plans and issued all the necessary permits for beautification work to begin on our neighborhood parks at Ella Lee and Larchmont, Olympia and Shepherd at Kirby. These parks are now substantially complete, thanks to the many generous donations we have received. Next in line for renovation and rejuvenation will be Briarwood Court, Sleepy Hollow Court and the Rebecca Meyer Park on Reba.

The River Oaks Foundation is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit corporation formed in 1999 for the purpose of raising funds, through voluntary tax-deductible contributions, for the beautification and preservation of the many common or public areas of our neighborhood.
